Location:

Race starts and finishes inside the Oktoberfest Grounds, directly in front of the DAS GLOCKENSPEIL stage; see the Oktoberfest map. <u>Please enter through the MAIN G</u>ATES, located on Jackson Avenue, near the shuttle drop off location.



Start Times:

Registration opens 5:30 pm

3 mile run 7:15 pm (following the 7:00 pm Das Glockenspiel show)

Packet Pickup:

Packet pickup will begin as follows at each Fleet Feet location during normal business hours: Blue Dome, KingsPointe Village, and Broken Arrow.

Tuesday, October 18 (KingsPointe: 10am to 7:30pm; Blue Dome and Broken Arrow: 11 am to 7 pm) Wednesday, October 19 (KingsPointe: 10am to 7:30pm; Blue Dome and Broken Arrow: 11 am to 7 pm) Thursday, October 20 (KingsPointe: 10am to 2pm; Blue Dome and Broken Arrow: 11 am to 2 pm) *** no packets will be available at the stores after 2 pm Thursday!

Packets will moved to the race location Thursday afternoon with packet pickup re-starting at 5:30 pm at the **BLUE FLEET FEET TENT** near the WILL CALL tent by the MAIN GATE!

It is STRONGLY recommended for this race that you pick up your packet in advance.

Course

See the attached course map. The 3 mile course is an out and back course on the newly paved Riverparks Trail, including the new pedestrian/bike bridge across the Arkansas River!

Race Number

Wear your race number on the front of your body! Do not remove the timing device from the race number for the three mile run.

Parking

Paid parking is available as shown on the attached parking map. Free shuttles are available from various locations around Tulsa, including downtown Tulsa and a stop near the Fleet Feet Blue Dome store (Fassler Hall). Might be a great location to meet up with your friends and then ride to the race together. You can either ride the shuttles for free, or you can pay to park on-site.

** Also, there is a volunteer shuttle that is available for race participants that picks up at SpiritBank, which is located across the Arkansas River from the Oktoberfest grounds (18th and Main Street).

Another option is to park on the east side of the River and walk across the 23rd Street Bridge to the Main Entrance of Oktoberfest.

All shuttles will begin operation at 4 pm on Thursday afternoon. Allow plenty of time to catch a shuttle and arrive at the race before the 7:15 PM start time if you choose to ride a free shuttle.

From the official Oktoberfest Guide:

PARKING AND SHUTTLES

THE FREE SHUTTLE SERVICE will operate from several locations around Tulsa: The Downtown Loop includes the Blue Dome District, The Tulsa Doubletree Hotel, Hyatt Regency Downtown and the Holiday Inn Tulsa City Center. The NEW Downtown Express Shuttle will operate directly from the Tulsa Transit Hub on South Denver Street to the Festival site. Shuttles will also service parking areas at the Trade Winds Central Inn, and the Crowne Plaza Southern Hills. See map for more details. The shuttles run 1 hour before and after festival hours, and will operate on Corporate Night (Wednesday) as well. The Downtown shuttles run every 5-10 minutes; the south shuttles run every 20-30 minutes. Paid parking is available (limited capacity) near the festival grounds for \$10.00 and \$20.00.

Gear Check

Your race number will also have a pull off tag for gear check – please use this to check gear so that after the race you do not have to go back to your car for your change of clothes. Bring your race packet bag to use for gear check. We are not liable for any lost or stolen items. Gear check will be located right at

the start/finish line inside the Oktoberfest grounds. Find the orange Fleet Feet VW BUS – it is the gear check location.

From the Oktoberfest Guide: Is there a limit on the size of bag I can bring inside?

Yes, <u>bags no larger than 13" x 15" x 6" will be permitted inside the Wiesn</u>. Guests who have bags larger than this size will be asked to return them to their vehicles. All bags will also be searched for prohibited items at entry before being scanned with metal detectors.

"Unoffical" Beer Stop

If you are over 21 and want to have a beer during the race we will have a beer stop at the turn of the 3 mile race on the east side of the Arkansas River. You must get a wrist band by showing your ID at registration/packet pickup on race day or at gear check inside the Oktoberfest grounds in order to be served a beer during this special stop.

Finish Line

As you finish the 3 mile race, all finishers will receive a Linde Oktoberfest 0.5 L Kleinkrug and a token to fill the Masskrug. In order to fill the Kleinkrug with beer, be prepared with your ID to show the bartenders at Oktoberfest. The wristband is only for our "unofficial" beer stop at the turn for the 3 mile race. We will also have bottled water at the finish line. If you do not want a beer we will have root beer at the finish line. To collect either the stein you must show your bib and trade the tab on your bib for the stein and/or root beer.

Post-Race Party

After you finish and retrieve your gear, you can enjoy all of the Oktoberfest activities. We will do overall and age group awards in the **GAMES AREA** at 8:15 pm. The games area is just beyond the finish line area. Collector chicken hats will be awarded to the age group winners (Top 3 per age group).
