

SUN Bucks provides \$120 in grocery benefits per eligible school-age child when school is out for summer. Children who get SUN Bucks can also participate in Summer Meals programs.

Your child may be eligible if your family's annual gross income* is LESS THAN: Family Income Family Size \$37,814 \$47,767 \$57,720 \$67,673

Can my child get SUN Bucks?

Your child will <u>automatically</u> get SUN Bucks if they participated in any of these programs between July 1, 2024- August 5, 2025:

- Children ages 6-16 years old and your family participated in SNAP or TANF.
- Children ages 6-16 years old and your family participated in AHCCCS with a household income of 185% of the FPL or below.
- Children ages 6-16 years old who are unhoused, foster, runaway, or migrant students.
- Children who attend a NSLP participating Head Start.
- Children who attended a school that participated in the NSLP in School Year 2024-2025 and who were certified for free or reduced-price meals

Your child may be eligible, consider applying for SUN Bucks if:

- Children that attend a school that operates the National School Lunch and/or School Breakfast Programs **AND** submitted a completed alternate income form with their child's school.
- Children that attend a school that serves free meals to all enrolled students AND they would qualify for free or reduced price school meals.

If you think your child is eligible based on your household income, visit the <u>Arizona Department of</u> Education application screener or call 833-648-4406 to find out if you should submit an application.

The SUN Bucks application will <u>close on August 5, 2025.</u>





- Families that participate in SNAP or TANF will receive funds directly to their existing household's Arizona EBT card.
- If you have an Arizona EBT card from Summer 2024, benefits will be loaded directly onto the EBT card. For questions, please contact the EBT card SUN Bucks hotline at 1 (833) 648-4406.
- If you do not have an Arizona EBT card, one will be mailed to you with your SUN Bucks benefits pre-loaded onto the card. The card works like a debit card.
- If you have more than one eligible child, you will only get one card per household. For example, if you have 2 eligible kids, you will get one card with \$240 total.
- SUN Bucks must be used within 122 days of the date when benefits are loaded onto the card. **Unused benefits will be removed on day 123.**

SUN Bucks

A Tested and Effective Strategy for Ending Summer Hunger



SUN Bucks is a program for States, Indian Tribal Organizations, and territories to provide food dollars to low-income families with school-age kids over the summer months. This program, also known as Summer Electronic Benefits Transfer (or Summer EBT), can help close the summer hunger gap when kids are on summer break and not getting nutritious school meals.

States, Indian Tribal Organizations, and territories offering SUN Bucks can provide about \$120 per eligible school-age child to families to buy groceries, similar to how USDA's Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits are used. SUN Bucks works hand-in-hand with other USDA nutrition programs to connect every eligible child with nutritious food in the summer.

SUN Bucks is a proven game-changer in the fight against child hunger.

SUN Bucks is an evidence–based program! Research shows that providing families with summer grocery benefits reduces child hunger and supports healthier diets.

USDA tested SUN Bucks as a demonstration project in select States and Indian Tribal Organizations for several years. **Rigorous evaluations** showed that SUN Bucks:

Decreased the number of kids with very low food security by one-third!

When kids are food insecure, they may skip meals or eat less because there isn't enough food to go around.

During the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency, States, Indian Tribal Organizations, and territories operated a temporary program similar to SUN Bucks, which demonstrated the potential of expanding the program nationwide. **Research found** that this program:



Do I need to apply for SUNBucks?

Did my child take part in any of these programs at any time from July 1, 2024, to August 5, 2025?

- -SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program)
- -TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families)
- -Medicaid with a household income at or below 185% of the federal poverty level (before deductions) *Income level clarified below.*

Student is a **foster** child, or in the **Homeless** Education Program



No further action is needed. No application necessary.

Because your child is enrolled in a qualifying public assistance program, they are automatically eligible for SUNBucks.
