ATTENDANCE MATTERS!

Chronic absenteeism is widely defined as missing 10 percent or more of school days in a school year for any reason, including excused and unexcused absences. This can translate into missing

15 or more

days per year or 3 days per month.

Students who are chronically absent in preschool, kindergarten, and first grade are much less likely to read at grade level by third grade—which would make them

4 times

more likely to drop out of high school than proficient readers.





MOBY MAX!

Dear AAEM Families, In an effort to ensure we target the specific needs of your child, your teachers will be assigning assessments via Moby Max to complete. This assessment series includes:

- Adaptive assessment to target specific skills levels
- Prior year benchmark (grades 1-8) to identify achievement gaps. For example 1st grade will take Kinder benchmark to identify areas of opportunity for targeted support and intervention.
