Hi Cider Mile Athlete!

Thank you for registering for the upcoming Schutt's Cider Mile on Saturday, November 6th! This event is an absolute blast!!

You can view the wave assignment you selected here. This way you know what time you are supposed to begin and when we can let you enter the start corral. The wave will also be on your bib. Each wave is a sequence of numbers so we know what numbers should be in each wave as they start.

Unfortunately, we are not able to change/adjust your wave and ask that you start with the wave that you selected. Otherwise your time will either not read or read long and it will affect the work the volunteers are doing.

Packet Pickup

 Friday, November 5th from 10am-7pm at Fleet Feet @ The Armory (155 Culver Rd, Rochester). We highly advise going to packet pickup to alleviate race day lines and congestion. Others can get your packet for you. Saturday, November 6th from 9 - 10AM. This will shut down at 10AM SHARP. If you have to wait until race day, you must get your packet before 10AM. This is not advised, so please, if you can go to packet pickup on Friday.

RULES

For those in the HARD CIDER event - YOU MUST BRING ID Saturday Morning in order to be allowed to participate in that category. You will be given a tyvek bracelet that must be worn showing you were ID'd.

For those in the Reg Apple Cider event - there will be a "Cider" decal on your bib to denote you are to get Regular Apple Cider ONLY. It also says Reg Apple Cider on your Bib.

The waves are at:

- · 10:00
- 10:15 (you can get ID'd and tyveked early, but can not enter start corral until after the 10AM race is gone from start - we will tell you)

- 10:30 (you can get ID'd and tyveked early, but can not enter start corral until after the 10:15AM race is gone from start - we will tell you)
- 10:45 (you can get ID'd and tyveked early, but can not enter start corral until after the 10:30AM race is gone from start - we will tell you)
- 11:00 (you can get ID'd and tyveked early, but can not enter start corral until after the 10:45AM race is gone from start - we will tell you)

Again do not forget ID if you are in the Hard Cider Category!!

PARKING

You may want to consider carpooling. Keep in mind this is at an Apple Farm.

THE COURSE

Keep in mind this is at an Apple Farm and ground conditions can be anything from snow to mud to pleasant hard packed dirt and it may be chilly still, thus the course is all within the farm fields.

How it works?

At the start we will congregate your wave at one time. Only be

in the wave you signed up for otherwise you will not be counted in any results and honestly cause extra challenges for volunteers setting up the cider stations.

When we say GO - this is when you drink your first glass of cider. Not before the GO. Do not litter. Put glass in receptacles. Then you can run to the next cider station. Follow the course markings. At the 2nd cider stop (be sure you are on the correct side (hard cider will be on one side and apple cider on another)). Drink your second glass.... don't litter.... place glass in receptacle then you are off to the 3rd stop then 4th stop to do the same thing then the finish.

Once done we encourage you to stop into Schutt's Apple Mill (caution crossing street) and peruse their delicious baked goods, farm fresh apples, their cidery and more. It's such a great store!! Perfect for an autumn day. You can possible preorder Thanksgiving pies too!

Again, Don't forget your ID Hard Cider Category folks!!
