 - ◆ Prevident 5000
 - ◆ Clinpro 5000
- ◆ High concentration fluoride rinse applied with brush
 - ◆ ACT Dry Mouth

Note: Products underlined in red should only be used with a prescription from a physician or dentist.

Chlorhexidine Gluconate 0.12% (alcohol-free) is indicated for use in people with severe gingivitis, oral infection, or who have a compromised immune system. Prescription strength fluoride pastes are indicated for use in people at especially high risk of developing caries.
