

2012 Wilmington Civitan Club Scholarship

The Wilmington Civitan Club is a giving group of people who donate their time and efforts to projects which benefit the local community. The Wilmington Civitan Scholarships provide financial support to high school students from New Hanover and Pender County who meet a defined set of criteria including character, financial need, service to the community and scholarship. The Scholarship is a one-time award of \$1,000, which will be paid directly to the educational institution.

<u>Criteria</u>: To qualify for the Wilmington Civitan Scholarship, an applicant must:

- Graduate from a high school in New Hanover County or Pender County
- Be enrolling full-time in an accredited two- or four-year college or university
- Demonstrate academic achievement and good moral character
- Have financial need as demonstrated by a completed "Scholarship Financial Information Form" and a FAFSA Student Aid Report

Required Items:

- Wilmington Civitan Scholarship Application Form (follows)
- Essay (typed, 250-500 words) that describes your plans and aspirations for college and beyond. Explain what has led you to choose this path and how a Wilmington Civitan scholarship can help you reach these goals. *Please put your name in the upper right corner of each page*.
- List of Extracurricular Activities On a single separate page, please provide a typed list of your extracurricular activities (clubs, sports, fine arts groups, volunteer work, scouting, hobbies, jobs, internships, etc.), including the years you participated and the number of hours per week devoted to each. Also list awards or recognitions you have received. *Please put your name in the upper right corner of the page*.
- Current or Most Recent Transcript (in sealed envelope) High School Seniors should submit an official high school transcript with test scores (SAT, ACT, AP)
- <u>Two</u> letters of Recommendation (in sealed envelopes) One letter should be from a teacher and one from a teacher, guidance counselor, coach, pastor, supervisor, or other qualified individual.
- NC Community Foundation Scholarship Financial Information Form (available on NCCF website)
- FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR) available by filing FAFSA at <u>www.fafsa.ed.gov</u>

<u>Complete</u> application packets must be postmarked by <u>Monday, April 2, 2012</u>, and mailed to Wilmington Civitan Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 264, Wilmington, NC 28402.

Please note that the Wilmington Civitan Scholarship Committee will not review incomplete applications. Students should keep a copy of the application in the event scholarship committee members have any questions.
