NORTHERN ALBEMARLE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION ANNOUNCES NEW FUND

The Northern Albemarle Community Foundation (NACF), an affiliate of the NC Community Foundation announces the establishment of the HCWGMW Donor Advised Fund in Elizabeth City, NC, according to Natalie Jenkins Peel, Regional Associate for the NC Community Foundation.

The HCWGMW Fund will provide grants to nonprofits serving various programs in Camden, Gates, Pasquotank and Perquimans Counties. The fund will support human service programs but will not support general operating. Brief Letters of Inquiry are requested to start the process. Accepted organizations will be asked to submit a full application; upon review grants will be awarded. Letters of Inquiry for the 2016 HCWGMW grant program must be submitted by May 1st. Estimated amount of annual grant funding available will be \$150,000.
