Northern Albemarle Community Foundation announces \$111,000 in local grants from the HCWGMW Fund

The Northern Albemarle Community Foundation announces \$111,000 in local grants from the HCWGMW Fund in Elizabeth City, according to Natalie Jenkins Peel, regional director.

Organizations invited to submit a proposal were selected based on serving the poor and youth-related needs in our four county service area; Pasquotank, Perquimans, Camden and Gates counties. Those organizations that are or are willing to collaborate with others in the community were a priority for funding.

Receiving grants from its inaugural cycle are the following organizations:

The next round of grant funding will focus on intentional community collaboration and healthy eating and active living initiatives.
