This year's nonprofit recipients include:

- \$5,000 to the Center for Volunteer Caregiving for capacity building through staff development
- \$4,500 to PLM Families Together for the Home for Families program
- \$4,500 to Triangle Family Services for the DOSE Batterer's Intervention program
