North Carolina Business & Development Incentives

Discretionary Programs

- <u>Job Development Investment Grant (JDIG)</u> Provides a limited number of cash grants to new and expanding businesses that will provide economic benefits to the State, and need the grant to carry out the project in North Carolina.
- <u>One North Carolina Fund</u> Awards grants for job creation and/or retention in conjunction with local government matches.

Cost Saving Programs

- Foreign Trade Zones Provides opportunities to defer, reduce and/or eliminate import duties.
- <u>Community Development Block Grant, Building Reuse Program</u> Provides grants and loans for infrastructure development to eligible local governments.
- Road Access Programs and Rail Access Programs Provides funds for the construction of roads and rail access to new or expanded industrial facilities.
- <u>North Carolina Biotechnology Center</u> Provides loans and matches to help leverage larger financial awards for biotechnology companies.
- <u>Film Incentives</u> Provides tax credits and sales and use tax discounts to encourage film and television production in North Carolina.

Tax Exemptions

- <u>Historic Preservation Tax Credit</u> These tax credits are available for the rehabilitation of incomeproducing historic properties and owner-occupied historic residences.
- <u>Sales and Use Tax Exemptions (Manufacturing)</u> North Carolina offers sales and use tax exemptions
 for manufacturing machinery and equipment; electricity, fuel and natural gas for manufacturing
 facilities, raw material for manufacturing, and inventories.
- <u>Pollution Control and Abatement & Recycling</u> The state offers property tax exclusions on pollution control and abatement equipment and recycling. It also offers a sales and use exemption for pollution control and abatement equipment.
- <u>Data Centers Sales & Use Tax Exemptions</u> North Carolina provides exemptions for Qualifying Data Centers, Eligible Internet Data Centers and Computer Software at Data Centers.
