Wendell Resident Indicted for First Degree Murder

Wendell- On June 30, 2013, the Wendell Police Department responded to a traffic crash involving a vehicle and a pedestrian on East Boxley Drive near Hollybrook Road. Once officers arrived on scene, they identified the victim as Maryland Jerome Vick. (a 24 year old black male) The driver of the 2006 Nissan Altima was identified as Camille Meijon Silver (a 22 year old black female).

During the initial investigation the scene was processed and numerous witnesses were interviewed.

On July 3, 2013, Maryland Vick died as a result of the injuries he sustained from this incident. After reviewing all available evidence and consulting with the Wake County District Attorney's office, Camille Silver was charged with Misdemeanor Death by Motor Vehicle and Failure to Reduce Speed on July 4, 2013.

The Wendell Police Department continued to work closely with the Wake County District Attorney's Office and the Raleigh Police Department on this complex investigation. New evidence was reviewed and additional interviews were conducted by the Wendell Police Department and staff of the Wake County District Attorney's office.

After review of all the evidence and statements that were obtained during this investigation, the Wendell Police Department and the Wake County District Attorney's Office decided to refer the case to a Wake County Grand Jury.

On Tuesday, September 9, 2014, this case was presented to a grand jury that heard testimony and issued a true bill of indictment, charging Camille Silver with First Degree Murder.

Chief Bill Carter said "This was a complex investigation that involved multiple agencies that worked closely together to ensure that all available evidence and leads were thoroughly investigated."
