### Missing Person

On Thursday, March 17, 2022, at 5:00 p.m., officers of the Wendell Police Department responded to 505 North Pine Street, in reference to a missing person. It was reported that Gregory Joseph Thomas had left his home at 6:15 a.m. that morning to go to work at Comfort Monster Heating and Air located in Raleigh. Mr. Thomas never arrived at work. Family reported that the last communication they had with Mr. Thomas was Thursday, March 17 at 6:37 a.m. and he stated he was driving through Knightdale.

Mr. Thomas (pictured below) is a 30-year-old black male that is 6'02" and weighs 150 pounds and is bald. He was last seen wearing dark blue work pants, purple work shirt with "Comfort Monster" logo and a Carhart jacket. Mr. Thomas was driving a dark grey Honda Civic displaying a North Carolina License Plate PEH-1355.
