Information as to those who served prior to Police Chief Alex Wall is not available. As information becomes available, the list will be updated.

The first and only assistant police chief position was authorized by the Town Board in 1969 for Ira Fuller due to Chief Red Couick taking on the duties of building and zoning.

When Assistant Police Chief Ira Fuller was promoted to police chief on July 8, 1974, the assistant chief’s position was abolished.

There were two sergeants authorized prior to 1983. Then two more were authorized under the leadership of Chief Joe Privette after 2002 and before 2008.

The first authorized lieutenant position was approved in 2009 under the leadership of Chief Johnson. This was upgraded to Captain in 2012.
