One of the most historic and sought-after properties in the world—the Vineyard was first owned and planted by Mrs. Thomas Rutherford in 1895, Georges de Latour, founder of Beaulieu, purchased the site in 1928 and it became home to BV's Rutherford Cabernets made by the elite winemaker Andre Tchelistcheff, though-out the '60s and '70s. The site was then purchased by Beckstoffer Vineyards in 1988. Andy, Dave and team have replanted using modern clones, trellising and spacing to yield optimum quality. Wines from this field consistently score in the high 90s, year after year and aside from the scores-these wines are just fantastic.
