A program that offers free tax help to people who make \$64,000 or less ensuring that 100% of the refund goes directly back to the customer. Volunteers provide basic return preparations with electronic filing. In addition, we educate clients about valuable tax credits and deductions that they are eligible for.

VITA Tax Season runs from **January - April 2024**. We are excited about how many community members we have been able to help so far.

# VITA Remote Site Review ACES Requirements

Remote Site Reviews (RSR) provides oversight at Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) and Tax Counseling for the Elderly T(TCE) sites. The reviews also evaluate the site's overall adherence to Quality Site requirements (QSR) and Volunteer Standards of Conduct (VSC).

Based on the results, United Way of Central Texas has met all ten of the Quality Site requirements. UWCT was commended on its commitment to the VITA program. "Your process from intake to tax prep to filing the returns is seamless and very organized. Your attention to detail allows taxpayers to have a professional, stress-free environment for their tax preparation. Your volunteers were easy to identify as they were wearing United Way name badges.
