Leaf Season is upon us! When raking your yard this season please remember the following:

- Pile leaves loosely and adjacent to the curb.
- If there is no curb, use the pavement edge or shoulder of the road.
- DO NOT place them on a sidewalk, ditch, street, or gutter.
- DO NOT add limbs, pine straw or other yard debris with the leaves.

Leaves will be picked up on a weekly basis. There is NO designated day for pickup.

Additionally...

Limbs and other yard debris must be separated and stacked adjacent to the curb. Limbs must be no more than 6" in diameter and no longer than 4' in length. There is NO designated day for pickup.

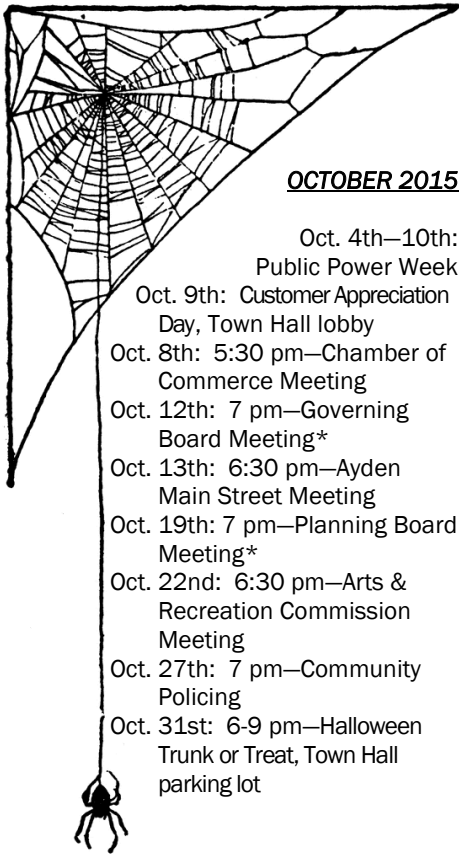
