We then plan to partner with Pitt Community College so they can provide educational opportunities to the public from that location. The Ayden Historic Society and Arts & Recreation Foundation are setting goals and initiatives to enhance and develop our community. And our Police Department and Board of Commissioners are working with Crime Stoppers to educate our citizens on the benefits of this program and how it works. (See article below for information).
