Position Summary:

Provide laboratory assistance to the Medical Laboratory Supervisor in completing task as assigned.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: General knowledge of applicable laboratory instrumentation and equipment; general knowledge of the test procedures performed in the laboratory including; skill in the use of laboratory equipment and in the performance of procedures; ability to make accurate observations and written reports of test results; ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions. Collect specimens for lab testing in house to include the following: Glucoses, 1hour glucose tolerance test, 3hour glucose tolerance test, Hemoglobin, Urine pregnancy tests, Rapid Strep test, Rapid Influenza A and B test, Urine dipsticks, Wet mounts, KOH, Gonorrhea cultures, and Stat male gram stains. To perform lab tests according to CLIA/OSHA guidelines. To analyze water samples for bacteria, perform Quality Control and Proficiency for Environmental Health. To package and send out all other specimens to reference laboratories as ordered by provider.

Education & Experience: Completion of a certified laboratory assistant course in medical technology or comparable course; or high school diploma and two years of medical laboratory experience; or an equivalent combination of training and experience. A minimum of three years of Phlebotomy experience with Adults and Children. (Phlebotomy Certification preferred but not required.)

Benefits: Two Medical/Dental Health Insurance options (available after 30 days of employment); Participation in Local Government Retirement System. 4% Employer contribution 401k, Employer-paid life insurance (1x annual salary); vacation/sick leave and 12 paid holidays/year.

Required Immunizations: The following are immunizations that we require for all employees prior to the first date of employment:

- Two step TST (skin test) If you have had a negative TST within the last 12 months, you must have another one completed prior to employment
- Proof of MMR (measles, mumps and rubella) immunity: You must have documentation of two doses of measles, mumps and rubella given at least 28 days apart or laboratory evidence of immunity or laboratory confirmation of disease
- Hepatitis B series: Either evidence of 3 doses; signed declination form or lab evidence of immunity
- Evidence of T-dap vaccine
- Evidence of varicella immunity: You must have documentation of two doses of varicella given at least 28 days apart or a history of varicella or herpes zoster based on physician diagnosis or laboratory evidence of immunity or laboratory confirmation of disease
- **If working in the lab, must have documented proof of one dose of meningococcal vaccine**
