Franklin County Board of Elections

Board Meeting – November 5, 2019 (Election Day)

The Franklin County Board of Elections met on this date at 5:00 pm. The following were present at that time: Chairperson Sonravea Privette, Secretary Larry Tucker, M. Rose Gill, Barry Gupton, Harry Barrick, Director Michelle Chavis, and Deputy Director Colette S. Kneeland.

Chairperson Sonravea Privette called the meeting to order and turned the meeting over to Director Michelle Chavis. The Director explained the purpose of the meeting was to tabulate the mail-in absentee ballots and close the polls for the early voting one-stop site for the 2019 Municipal Election.


Director Michelle Chavis gave the mail-in absentee ballot envelopes to the Board Members and explained the process of tabulating the mail-in absentee ballots. There were 33 approved mail-in absentee ballots to be tabulated for election night reporting. After the tabulation of the mail-in absentee ballots, the DS200 results tape was signed by all five Board Members and together they placed the ballots in their proper container and security sealed them with two numbered security seals, while Deputy Director Colette S. Kneeland recorded the seal numbers, read as follows: #48132 and #48152.

The Board Members asked Director Michelle Chavis to close the polls on the DS200 one-stop tabulator. After the results tape was completed all five Board Members signed the results tape and together, they placed the one-stop ballots in their proper container and security sealed them with two numbered security seals, while Deputy Director Colette S. Kneeland recorded the seal numbers, read as follows: #48125 and #48161.

Director Michelle Chavis stepped out of the meeting to generate the unity results report from the mail-in absentee and one-stop tabulator tapes. She gave the Board Members an absentee abstract sheet to record the total number of absentee votes from the mail-in absentee ballots and the one-stop (early voting) ballots as she read them aloud from the unity results report. The absentee abstract for the 2019 Municipal Election was signed by all five Board Members and notarized by the Director.

Secretary Larry Tucker made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Board Member M. Rose Gill. The vote was unanimous.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:17 pm.
