### Franklin County Board of Elections

#### Board Meeting – November 23, 2020 (Re-canvass)

The Franklin County Board of Elections met on this date at 7:00 am. The following were present at that time: Chairperson Sonravea Privette, Secretary Harry Barrick, Board Members M. Rose Gill, Barry Gupton, Angela Pearce (Virtual), Director Michelle Chavis and Deputy Director Colette S. Kneeland.

Chairperson Sonravea Privette called the meeting to order and turned the meeting over to Director Michelle Chavis. The Director explained that the purpose of the meeting was to Recanvass the 2020 Presidential General Election per the State Board of Elections.

#### New Business

Director Michelle Chavis reviewed the State Board of Elections Audit findings from the Canvass of the 2020 Presidential Election with the Board. She explained that the state reported that 6 voters had voted twice (absentee & Election Day). The State required that the county make the manual edits to the UNITY system to deduct the 6 absentee votes and recanvass the 2020 Presidential General Election. Board Secretary Harry Barrick made a motion, seconded by Board Member Barry Gupton to deduct the duplicate votes from the absentee ballots. The vote was unanimous. The Director provided the Board with tally sheets for the absentee ballots and the election results to verify the manual edits. The Board Members signed the election abstracts and the Director notarized them.

#### Other Business


Board Member Hazard Pay

November 23, 2020


