Position Summary: This advanced health education position is directly responsible for increasing the number of individuals trained and delivering the evidence-based “Positive Parenting Program” (referred to as “Triple-P”) within Franklin, Granville, Vance and Warren counties. Based at the Franklin County Health Department, the position requires frequent same-day traveling to promote Triple-P within our 4-county region, and also requires regular attendance at regional and state-wide meetings (related transportation, food and lodging are covered by the program). Successful candidates will have solid rapport-building and public speaking skills as well as an ability to track and report on activities, resources and outcomes. Prior education/experience in marketing is a plus, and a strong understanding of grant management principles is required. Ability to effectively utilize: MS Excel and PowerPoint; client engagement tools (i.e. Eventbrite; Survey Monkey; Doodle etc.); and online supply ordering is required.

Education or Experience Requirement: A master’s degree in public health education; **or** graduation from a four-year college or university with a major in health education and two years of experience in public health education or a related field; **or** graduation from a four-year college or university and three years’ experience in public health education; **or** an equivalent combination of training and experience. A Valid North Carolina Driver’s license is required.

Benefits: Two Health insurance options; insurance begins the first day of the month after 30 days of employment; employer paid 4% 401K; life insurance; 12 paid holidays; paid vacation and sick leave.

Required Immunizations

The following are immunizations that we require for all employees prior to the first date of employment:

- Two step TST (skin test) If you have had a negative TST within the last 12 months, you must have another one completed prior to employment
- Proof of MMR (measles, mumps and rubella) immunity: You must have documentation of two doses of measles, mumps and rubella given at least 28 days apart or laboratory evidence of immunity or laboratory confirmation of disease
- Hepatitis B series: Either evidence of 3 doses; signed declination form or lab evidence of immunity
- Evidence of Tdap vaccine
- Evidence of varicella immunity: You must have documentation of two doses of varicella given at least 28 days apart or a history of varicella or herpes zoster based on physician diagnosis or laboratory evidence of immunity or laboratory confirmation of disease
- **If working in the lab, must have documented proof of one dose of meningococcal vaccine**
