

**AUGUST 18, 1992**

The Board of Commissioners of Franklin County, North Carolina reconvened meeting recessed from August 17, 1992 at 7:00 P. M. in the Conference Room of the Franklin County Office Building with the following Commissioners present: Chairman Robert L. Swanson, Vice Chairman James G. Hardy, Commissioner Harry L. Foy, Jr., Commissioner Ronald W. Goswick and Commissioner George T. Wynne.

Upon motion by Commissioner Goswick, seconded by Commissioner Wynne with all present voting "AYE" duly carried County Attorney Pete Tomlinson appointed to serve as Clerk to the Board for this meeting.

Surapon Sujjavanich, Architect for proposed law enforcement facility, was present and presented the preliminary plans for the proposed new law enforcement center to the Board of Commissioners, Sheriff Robert Redmond and Chief Jailer E. H. Smith. There was a lengthy discussion, no action taken.

Upon motion by Commissioner Wynne, seconded by Commissioner Hardy with all present voting "AYE" duly carried in order to clarify motion made during meeting on August 17, 1992, to remove Dr. B. L. Patterson and Ms. Marguerite Moore from the Franklin County Board of Health that they be removed from the Board of Health for cause - Dr. B. L. Patterson because he is no longer a licensed practicing physician and Ms. Marguerite Moore because of conflict of interest.
