

MAY 23, 1994

The Franklin County Board of Commissioners reconvened regular meeting recessed from May 16, 1994 at 7:30 P. M. in the Superior Courtroom of the Franklin County Courthouse with the following Commissioners present: Chairman George T. Wynne, Vice Chairman James T. Moss, Jr., Commissioner Harry L. Foy, Jr., Commissioner James G. Hardy and Commissioner Robert L. Swanson.

Proper notice having been given this is the time and place set for a public hearing to receive comments on the proposed 1994-1995 Franklin County Budget.

Chairman Wynne declared public hearing open at 7:40 P. M. and called for public comments and the following people spoke:

-comments regarding increase in Landfill tipping fees

Grady Macon, Route 1, Box 150A, Youngsville, NC
-comments regarding increases in Governing Body, Manager, Board of Elections, Planning & Development,
EMS --comments on Pay Plan and Certificates of Participation

R. B. Gill, III, Route 2, Franklinton, NC
-comments on school construction funds, jail construction - no tax increase

Mike Monkusky, Youngsville, NC
-comments on tax increase hard on poor and elderly--include in jail only what is necessary--inconvenient hours
at convenient centers; employees at centers not doing good job--tipping fee too high

Jacqueline Bradshaw, Route 6, Louisburg, NC
- comments regarding solid waste tax and fire department tax included on automobile tax bill

Chairman Wynne declared public hearing closed at 8:45 P. M.

The Board set Tuesday, May 31, 1994 and Thursday, June 2, 1994 as work sessions on the proposed 1994-1995 Franklin County Budget.

Harold Annis, Architect, appeared before the Board to review the drawings for the Franklin County District Court Annex.

Upon motion by Commissioner Swanson, seconded by Commissioner Moss, Voting "AYE", Commissioner Swanson, Commissioner Moss, Commissioner Hardy and Commissioner Wynne; Voting "NO" Commissioner Foy, authorize Architect Harold Annis to proceed with the preparation of construction drawings and specifications for the Franklin County District Court Annex.

Upon motion by Commissioner Moss, seconded by Commissioner Swanson, voting "AYE" Commissioner Moss, Commissioner Swanson, Commissioner Hardy and Commissioner Wynne, voting "NO" Commissioner Foy, that the recreation policy be revised for this year to include salaries upon the condition that each unit receiving funds submit to the Board of Commissioners a report by October 1, 1994, outlining how funds were spent and the benefits received; each unit receiving the funds is urged to spend as much as possible on capital outlay items.

Pursuant to and in accordance with General Statutes 143-318.11 and upon motion by Commissioner Swanson, seconded by Commissioner Hardy, voting "AYE" Commissioner Swanson, Commissioner Hardy, Commissioner Moss and Commissioner Wynne, voting "NO" Commissioner Foy, the Board went into executive session to discuss land acquisition and litigation.

The Board reconvened into regular session and Chairman Wynne stated no action needed as a result of the executive session.

There being no further business to come before the Board, adjournment recorded at 10:30 P. M.
