## Franklin County Planning Director Graduates County Administration Course

*Patrick Young is one of 33 officials to graduate this year*

**Louisburg, April 20, 2007:** Pat Young, Franklin County Planning and Inspections Director, has successfully graduated from the 2006-2007 County Administration Course of the School of Government, University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

The program in County Administration is designed for managers, department heads, and officials whose responsibilities require a broad understanding of functions beyond individual areas of specialization. The course is approximately 150 hours in length, and more than 40 instructors participate in leading the program. Course instruction covers North Carolina government law, organization and management, finance and budgeting, personnel law and administration, planning and regulation of development, and the delivery of specific city or county services.

Pat Young was one of 33 officials who graduated the course this year and is one of over 1,150 officials who have completed the course since it began in 1964.
