Franklin County Library "Food for Amnesty" Week, December 17-22, 2007

Louisburg, December 6, 2007: The Franklin County Library will exchange (\$1.00) one dollar of amnesty toward patron fines for a can of food during the week prior to the Christmas holiday. The food collected by the libraries will be distributed by Care and Share. Amnesty will apply to existing fines only and will not offset fines yet to be incurred. Cans of food must have original labeling attached by the manufacturer, be in good condition and within the "best buy (date)" status as indicated by the manufacturer. In the spirit of giving library patrons can clear their fines and share the bounty of small favors that mean so much to those in need. Additional donations of canned food will be accepted.
