

FRANKLIN COUNTY PLANNING BOARD

February 13, 2013

The Franklin County Planning Board held its regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, February 13, 2013 in the Franklin County Administration Building, Commissioners Meeting Room, 113 Market Street, Louisburg, North Carolina.

Vice Chairman William Wallace called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.; and welcomed everyone in attendance. New members Johnnie Sledge and Carolyn Paylor were introduced to the board. Steve Mitchell gave the invocation. Mary Solomon made a motion, seconded by Mark McArn to approve the minutes from the November 13, 2012 meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

#1. Election of Officers

Robert Mann made a motion, seconded by Carolyn Paylor to nominate William Wallace to serve as Chairman. With no other motions on the floor, the nomination was closed and the motion passed unanimously.

William Wallace made a motion, seconded by William Holden to nominate Mark McArn to serve as Vice Chairman. With no other motions on the floor, the nomination was closed and the motion passed unanimously.

The Planning Board nominated Tammy Davis to continue to serve as Clerk. With no other nominations on the floor, the nomination was closed and the motion passed unanimously.

#2. UDO Amendment: Article 2 Section 2-2 Definitions of Basic Terms; Article 19 Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance.

Jason Rogers stated staff was recently contacted by Steve Garrett of North Carolina Department of Public Safety Division of Emergency Management with some changes to Article 2 and Article 19 of the UDO. He stated in order to qualify for the National Flood Insurance Program; staff is proposing changes to the UDO. Mr. Rogers summarized the proposed additions and changes. Mark McArn made a motion, seconded by Fannie Brown to recommend approval of the proposed amendment. The motion passed unanimously.

Scott Hammerbacher informed the Board that the Special Use Permit for a Shooting Range heard previously by the Planning Board was denied by the Board of County Commissioners. He stated the applicants had filed appeals with the Board of Adjustment and Superior Court.
