

NCCF Scholarship Awards

Facts and Figures



In the 2022 scholarship season, NCCF awarded \$1,102,259 in direct scholarship aid to 265 students from across North Carolina.

- 305 individual scholarships were awarded from 100 NCCF scholarship funds in 2022.
- 75 of the 2022 NCCF scholars are first-generation college students.
- This year's NCCF scholarship recipients hail from 116 North Carolina cities and towns, and they are now studying at 66 different schools in 15 states across the country.
- This year, 196 scholarships, totaling \$735,165, were awarded to female scholars, 107 scholarships, totaling \$360,131, were awarded to male scholars and 2 scholarships, totaling \$6,963, were awarded to nonbinary scholars.
- 55 of the current NCCF scholars will graduate in the 2022-2023 academic year!
- 41 of the schools attended by 2022 NCCF scholars are in North Carolina, meaning \$980,434 in scholarship dollars stayed right here in our state.

2022 NCCF scholars attended:

- 13 public universities in North Carolina totaling \$824,074
- 14 private colleges and universities in North Carolina totaling \$114,955
- 14 community colleges in North Carolina totaling \$41,405

21 scholarships, totaling \$61,425

UNC-WILMINGTON

19 scholarships, totaling \$79,770
