Wake Transit Work Plan Amendment Requests Now Available for Public Comment

Community members can review and submit comments through April 27th

The City of Raleigh, Town of Cary, Town of Holly Springs, and GoTriangle, as project sponsors, have requested consideration of two major and 42 minor funding amendments for the FY2022 Wake Transit Work Plan.

The Wake County Transit Planning Advisory Committee (TPAC) plans to consider the amendments during its April 20, 2022 meeting. The amendments affect the 4th Quarter FY2022 Wake Transit Work Plan budget. Therefore, they are available to members of the Wake Transit community for their review and comment.

In addition, the TPAC must consider the amendments and public comments before recommending them for approval by the Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) Executive Board and GoTriangle Board of Trustees.

The two major amendments include the following items:

1) Farebox Upgrades and Mobile Ticket Technology – This major amendment request came from GoTriangle. It seeks to reduce a portion of previously adopted funding for the farebox upgrades and mobile ticketing technology project based on updated needs.

Farebox Collection Technology Upgrades - This major amendment request came from the City of Raleigh. It seeks to reduce previously adopted funding
for the farebox upgrades and mobile ticketing technology based on project status.

A summary of the major and minor amendment requests, along with documentation for each individual major request, is available below.


