The bulk of the discussion focused on continued development of a single demographics question to beta test with both the GTCR and combined Wake Bus Plan/FY24 Work Plan engagement efforts. Then attendees began discussing the development of performance targets that will apply to future Wake Transit engagement efforts. GoTriangle will provide a recommended path forward for the process, with understanding that it will take some time to finalize them.
