One of the remaining tasks within the scope of the FY2025-2030 Wake Bus Plan development process is to update the Wake Transit Service Standards and Performance Guidelines that are used annually to review route performance. The draft was reviewed during the August PD Subcommittee meeting. Members discussed implementation of the Service Impact Benefit as drafted a felt that an expansion of the original eligibility requirements to include more services should be considered. Lead agency staff evaluated the member suggestions and have put together a scenario that maintains the overarching equity objective of the benefit while opening up the eligibility requirements to additional routes. Attachment A is the draft Service Standards and Performance Guidelines document shared in August. Attachment B is the proposed edits to the Service Impact Benefit sections of the draft.

Draft Update to Wake Bus Plan: ADA Funding Policy

ADA/Paratransit reimbursement was discussed early in the FY2025-2030 Wake Bus Plan development process. The draft policy outlines a process for budgeting and reimbursing the costs of providing ADA paratransit services on Wake Transit routes. PD members reviewed the draft policy at their August meeting and requested that clarification about how the 15% reimbursable policy would be implemented and for what span of time be further defined in the policy, as well as agreeing that CFA Program projects would not be subject to the policy. Clarifications, based upon member recommendations, have been made to the policy, Attachment C, and will be reviewed and discussed as an action item in October.

<u>Action:</u> Review and recommend the FY2025-2030 Wake Bus Plan: ADA Funding Policy to the TPAC for consideration.
