9. Project Presentation: Knightdale Route 33 Crosswalk & Sidewalk Project (Information Item: Andrew Spiliotis, 10 minutes) Attachment B & C

The Town of Knightdale's CFAP project is to design and construct crosswalks at three intersections along Knightdale Blvd (64 Bus.) where GoRaleigh Route 33 operates, and design sidewalk gaps along the west side of Old Knight Rd between Forestville Rd and Knightdale Blvd. The CFAP funded project will add crosswalks at the following Knightdale Blvd intersections at: Hinton Oaks Blvd (east leg), Parkside Commons Dr/Bozeman Dr (west leg) and Old Knight Road / N. 1st Ave. (north and east legs). The sidewalk component will create a continuous pedestrian route between Knightdale High School and downtown / Route 33 bus stops. The project was developed as one of three hot spot projects in our 2022 CTP which included substantial outreach. Proposed CFAP project outreach methods will include a website, social media posts, an open house, yard signs and flyers at bus stops and crosswalk locations, targeted outreach to Knightdale High School and Spanish language flyers at a key community.
