On October 9<sup>th</sup>, the TPAC confirmed CAMPO's designation as the lead agency responsible for facilitating a Wake Transit lead agency assignment review and update process. Discussion and decision-making for this task will flow from the ILA partners to the PD Subcommittee to the TPAC and then adoption by the governing boards. The timeline to update the lead agency assignments and associated Operating Guidelines, Attachment B & C, is anticipated to occur between October 2024 and March 2025 so that final recommendations can be incorporated into the recommended FY26 Wake Transit Work Plan. Supporting this task has been added to the Subcommittee's August-January Work Task List, Attachment A.

**Requested action**: Approve an edit to the Program Development Subcommittee's August-January Work Task List to include support for the process to review and update the Wake Transit Lead Agency Assignments and Operating Guidelines.

Projects eligible for Art funding may receive up to \$30,000 for Artist Retention; reimbursable prior to the completion of 60% project design phase. At the end of FY2024, 4 projects were approved for Artist Retention Fees.

Artist Retention: Through the end of FY2024:

• The City of Raleigh was reimbursed \$60,000 for Artist Retention

Art Funding: Through the end of FY2024:

• The City of Raleigh was reimbursed \$78,000 for Art Funding

Real Property: Through the end of FY2024:

- The Town of Cary was reimbursed \$19.2M for Land Acquisition
- The City of Raleigh was reimbursed \$18.0M for Land Acquisition
- GoTriangle was reimbursed \$952K in FY21 for 5 parcels, however, in FY24 GoTriangle sold two parcels and refunded \$612K to the Wake Transit Fund; the Wake Transit Plan share of the 3 remaining parcels is \$383K.

#### 6. Overview of revised Cost Estimate for Poole Road Facility

The most recent cost estimate for the Poole Road operations and maintenance facility has come in \$19 million over the current project allocation. City staff will provide an overview of the project and explanation for the overages. They will be requesting the needed additional funds as part of the FY26 Wake Transit Work Plan call for projects.
