- Participate in discussions on technology needs
- Provide insight from their perspective organizations
- Discuss the potential impacts implementing suggested technology and how providers can work together to ensure Transit funding is supporting a faster, cost effective, comfortable, convenient, safe and reliable transit network.
- Discuss potential financial implications for future workplans
