Summary: GoRaleigh has advanced design of the Wake Bus Rapid Transit (BRT): Western Corridor to the 30% milestone, and as such planned public engagement related to that milestone. 11. Workgroup Updates

- a. **Regional Technology** (Austin Stanion) – Workgroup findings are being presented to PD Subcommittee for recommendation in August. Anticipate TPAC action to approve the implementation framework and funding strategy in September.
- b. **Budget & Finance** (Steve Schlossberg) Steve has received the fare collection data needed from GoTriangle and Raleigh data is expected soon. Then a meeting to discuss fares and other tasks of the Workgroup will be scheduled.
- c. **Scope & Deliverables** (Paul Kingman/Steven Mott) 1st meeting held on July 29, 2026. A second meeting is expected in Sept/Oct.

12. Wake Transit Engagement Update

- b. A CAMPO required 30-day comment period on four proposed Wake BRT LPAs kicked off on August 17 and will run to September 16th. The four corridors include: Western Extension to RTP, Southern Extension to Clayton, Mid-Town and Triangle Town Center.
