**\$7** county vehicle registration fee

**\$3** increase to regional vehicle registration





#### **TPAC**



(ILA) The Interlocal Agreement was to ensure decision making for the Wake Transit is equitable for all stakeholders.



Transit Planning Advisory Committee **(TPAC)** is the technical team charged with implementing the Adopted Wake Transit Plan.

Previsions have been made for weighted voting

**TPAC** makes recommendations on how the dollars are spent.

Policy decisions are sent to the governing boards simultaneously for approval



**Requiring Council Action** 

\$7 Vehicle Registration Tax ILA\*
(Jan. 2017)

•Interim \$7 Vehicle Registration Fee Agreement

**30-40 Year Agreement** 

Joint Agency Agreement (Feb. 2017)

- •Supersedes \$7 Vehicle Registration Tax ILA
- •Overarching agreement for any party wishing to participate in use of Wake Transit Tax process
- •Agreement addressing rules of engagement for Wake Transit Implementation activities
- •All Wake municipalities invited as signing parties

#### **5 Year Operating Program**

#### **Master Implementation Agreement**

- •Agreement addressing local grouping of projects that drills down to programmatic provisions
- •Signatories are specific project implementers and GoTriangle as Tax District Administrator

#### **Annual**

Annual Capital/Operating Funding Agreements

• Legal authorization of funding for projects for specified annual or biennial period

\* Once the agreement is signed all proceeds from the \$7 vehicle registration tax will go to the tax district/jurisdiction
