- Each local government member is apportioned weighted voting at the beginning of each respective calendar year based on the most recent Certified Population Estimates released by the North Carolina Office of State Budget and Management (NCOSBM) utilizing a vote weighting formula of one vote for each 50,000 in population, or portion thereof.
- Wake County's population is the most recent county population estimate released by the NCOSBM less the population of the Wake County portions of the municipalities otherwise represented on the TPAC. This includes the populations of municipalities' extraterritorial jurisdictions that are not included within municipalities' corporate limits.

- When weighted voting is invoked, member agencies with two (2) members must vote as a single voting block such that all of the weighted vote assigned to the respective agency is uniformly applied to one side of the vote.
