Recommendation: The Council of Planning will provide an advisory recommendation to the Town of Wake Forest and Wake County Public School System on this proposed project.
- 3:30 – 3:55 pm** **US 1 Corridor Plan and Access Management Issues – Franklin County**
During the US 1 Corridor Study exercise, Franklin County began to experience new developments and access challenges around the NC 96 intersection. Future road designs and accesses for US 1 must account for those new developments. As a result, Mr. Pat Young, Franklin County’s Planning Director, will address general issues involving access management along US 1 in Franklin County; and the steps Franklin County plans to take for successful implementation of the US 1 Corridor Study recommendations.
