VI. Freeway and Street-Based Transit (FAST) Study

(Information Item: Taruna Tayal and Don Bryson, VHB, 20 minutes)

Funded by the Regional Transportation Alliance (RTA), GoTriangle and NCDOT, the Freeway And Street-based Transit (FAST) study is developing an illustrative, scalable approach to transform our roadways into multimodal corridors that can provide rapid, frequent, and reliable transit service across the region.

The proposed FAST network will capitalize on the great work that has already been done by the various transit agencies in the Triangle; complement existing and future investments being made in accordance with transit



studies, plans and implementation; and leverage the existing freeway and street system with targeted transit advantages to improve accessibility and opportunity.

Preliminary findings were released on July 16th via a free webinar; the presentation, recording, and companion materials are available via <u>www.letsgetmoving.org/FASTstudy</u>. Comments are being requested from transportation partners and the public through August 31st.
