FY21 WAKE TRANSIT WORK PLAN











Because efforts to curb the coronavirus pandemic are expected to significantly affect many kinds of tax collection, the Wake County Transit Planning Advisory Committee is recommending that most new Wake Transit improvements proposed for fiscal year 2021 be delayed until available revenues can be better assessed later this year.

PROJECTS RECOMMENDED FOR FUNDING BEGINNING AFTER JULY 1

- GoTriangle's 305 extension and GoCary's Apex-Cary Express will provide peak hour service connecting Holly Springs to transit for the first time.
- GoApex Route 1 Fixed-Route Circulator: NEW hourly frequency fixed-route circulator to run throughout Apex
- GoApex Route 1: Bus Stop Installation/Improvements
- GoRaleigh Route 21 (Caraleigh) improvements: Monday Friday Midday frequency improvements (from 60 minutes -> to every 30 minutes) and all day on Weekends until 7 PM (60 -> 30)
- Town of Morrisville: Installation/Improvements to Bus Stops and Nodes for Node-Based Smart Shuttle
- Northeastern Wake County Microtransit Study
- Final design, right-of-way acquisition, construction, and procurement of vehicles for New Bern Avenue BRT
