








Process/Consultant Selection





Purpose

- Water resource and land management considerations
- Evaluate watershed water supply capacity & other environmental regulatory considerations
- Long-term vision for development patterns

- Multi-modal transportation network
- Implementation strategy short-term and mid-term recommendations to aid with implementation of long-term vision

Objectives

- Land use and multi-modal transportation recommendations, in response to agreed-upon land use vision for the study area
- Establish/enhance transportation system that includes key transportation corridors, pedestrian & bicycle facilities, rail and freight corridors, and transit to meet mobility needs of the area
- Robust engagement to help secure stakeholder and local jurisdiction buy-in
- Transportation recommendations will inform the 2055 Metropolitan Transportation Plan

RFP Highlights

Required Sections:

- 1. General Experience including successful past collaborations among team members and any project-specific experience
- 2. Proposed Approach clear approach to achieve multiple project goals and proposed timeline including deliverables and meetings
- **3. References** including email and phone number for relevant / similar projects over the past 5 years

- 4. **Project Team** resumes for key team members, outline of any project-specific work experience; organizational chart
- 5. General Information profile of the firm and description of current projects; additional information the firm feels would be useful during the evaluation process
- 6. Vendor ID Numbers NCDOT and Town of Cary Vendor IDs required by the time of submittal.

RFP Highlights, cont.

Page limit = 20 (+ 1-page cover)

◆Budget = \$290,000

♦1 digital PDF submittal
