



MOST DEATHS AND SERIOUS INJURIES CAN BE PREVENTED IF WE FOCUS ON ...

- · Keeping vehicles in the lane
- · Reducing conflicts at intersections
- · Decreasing drug and alcohol impairment
- · Using seat belts and child car seats
- Improving routes and crossings for pedestrians, bicyclists and motorcyclists
- · Slowing vehicle speeds

Use:

 The infographic demonstrates the need to pursue a transportation safety plan in the CAMPO region as well as strategies reducing fatalities and serious injuries on roadways. Posters will be region specific.

Information Collection:


 No information needs to be collected in this material. The poster requires an easel.




