


The transportation safety plan focuses on reducing crashes that result in death or serious injury, for all roads and all modes of travel






DID YOU KNOW THAT IN FRANKLIN COUNTY BETWEEN 2019 AND 2023...?

More than 7,300 reported crashes occurred on local and state roadways


Of those crashes, **More than 460 people** were killed or seriously injured

WHERE DO WE PRIORITIZE TRANSPORTATION SAFETY?

Interstates, US routes, or NC routes represent about 12% of the roadway network in Franklin County, but More than 46% of fatal and serious injury crashes occurred on these roads



INTERSTATES, US, AND NC ROUTES

MOST DEATHS AND SERIOUS INJURIES CAN BE PREVENTED IF WE FOCUS ON ...

- Keeping vehicles in the lane
- Reducing conflicts at intersections
- Decreasing drug and alcohol impairment
- Using seat belts and child car seats
- Improving routes and crossings for pedestrians, bicyclists and motorcyclists
- Slowing vehicle speeds
