Wake BRT: Rapid Bus Extensions Study Seeking Comments on Draft Recommendations by December 16

RALEIGH, N.C.-The final phase of the Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization's (CAMPO) Rapid Bus Extensions study (MIS) is underway. Continued public engagement is an essential part of this study which evaluated and is recommending rapid bus routing for extensions to both of the planned Wake Bus Rapid Transit (BRT): Western and Southern Corridors. Alignment alternatives were refined based on community feedback during the spring of 2022, and draft recommendations are now being presented for community review. CAMPO is requesting comments on the study's draft results and the proposed recommended alignment for both the Western and Southern Corridor extensions.

The planned Wake BRT: Western Corridor will connect downtown Raleigh to downtown Cary, and the extension includes the area between Cary and the Research Triangle Park. The planned Wake BRT: Southern Corridor will connect downtown Raleigh to Garner, and the extension includes the area between Garner to Clayton. Community input is key at this stage to finalize the recommended alignments. There are several ways for the community to participate.
