In addition to public participation on the air quality process, each MPO had a parallel public process for input and review of the relevant MTP and TIP documents. Although not specifically a part of the air quality work, the MPOs have information related to the public engagement on their MTP and TIP documents on their websites. As an example, CAMPO staff updates the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) every two years. For the 2020-29 TIP, a draft TIP was completed that meets the federal requirement stating that the TIP and STIP must be identical. CAMPO's public involvement policy required that the draft TIP be released for a public review and comment period and that a public hearing be conducted to receive comment on the draft TIP. Staff released the Draft 2020-2029 Transportation Improvement Program for public review and comment from September 5,2019 to October 7,2019 and scheduled a public hearing at the October 16,2019 Executive Board meeting.




