### BOARD MEETING MINUTES FEBRUARY 27, 2024 5:00 pm

The Montgomery County Board of Elections met Tuesday, February 27, 2024, at 5:00 pm at the BOE Office at 327 Main St in Troy, NC. Present were Dree Wynkoop, Debbie Burris, Teddi Benson, John Adams, and Tasha Medley. Also, present was the Director of Elections, Rhonda Johnson and Donna Moore, office assistant of Elections.

Chair Benson called the meeting to order 5:00 pm.

Chair Benson asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. John Adams asked that the minutes be held, until the board can read them. Everyone agreed.
