

Detention Sanitation Considerations

808.1 CONTROLLED SHOWER PROGRAM

To maintain the safety and security of the staff and inmates, the Montgomery County Detention Center will operate a controlled Shower Program in its maximum or special population housing units. The control room officer and escorting officers are responsible for insuring no other inmates in the housing unit are out while the Controlled Shower Program is in operation. Inmates shall have access to showers a minimum of three times per week.

808.2 ENVIRONMENTAL SANITATION

To maintain the safety of the facility and to promote the health and well-being of staff, inmates, and persons visiting the Detention Center, Detention Officials will ensure that the Montgomery County Detention Center conforms to applicable rules and regulations pertaining to environmental sanitation and hygiene. At a minimum, the Detention Center will comply with the rules of the North Carolina Commission for Health Services that govern sanitation.

808.3 FACILITY HOUSEKEEPING PLAN

To ensure the adequate appearance of the Montgomery County Detention Center, it will be the responsibility of Detention Officers to assign an adequate number of inmate workers to clean the Detention Center on a daily basis. Daily housekeeping/sanitation inspections will be conducted by the shift supervisor and by every Detention Officer on duty during each shift to ensure the cleanliness of the facility.

808.4 MAINTENANCE OF FIXTURES, EQUIPMENT, AND FURNISHINGS

To ensure that all equipment and fixtures in the Montgomery County Detention Center are in safe, operable condition and meet the minimum standards of local, state, and or federal codes, the Detention Administrator / Designee will ensure that a schedule for the maintenance and inspection of all such equipment and fixtures is developed and followed by county maintenance personnel and place any necessary work orders to facilitate repairs.
