The Juvenile Crime Prevention Council (JCPC) has studied the risk factors and needs of Juvenile Court involved youth in this county and hereby publishes this Request for Proposals. The JCPC anticipates funds from the NC Department of Public Safety, Division of Administration, Community Programs section in the amount stated above to fund the program types specified below. Such programs will serve delinquent and at-risk youth for the state fiscal year 2019-2020 beginning on, or after, July 1, 2019. The use of these funds in this county requires a local match in the amount specified above.

The JCPC will consider proposals for the following needed programs:

Parent/Family Skills	Restitution/Community Service	Substance Abuse Treatment
Interpersonal Skills	Psychological Assessment	Academic Enhancement/Tutoring
Mentoring and Peer Mentoring	Temporary Shelter	Vocational Development
Mediation	Juvenile Structured Day Treatment	

Proposed program services should target the following risk factors for delinquency or repeat delinquency:

*School Behavior Problems	*Domestic discord and violence in families
*Peer Relationships	*Age of First Delinquent Offense- under age 12 yrs.
*Academic Functioning	*Parental ability to provide supervision of youth
*Substance Abuse	*Family Criminality

Programs should address the following concerns as reported in the Needs Assessments for adjudicated youth:

Peer Domain: Poor peer relationships, association with delinquent peers and have a history of victimization.

Individual Domain: Substance use/abuse and mental health needs.

Family Domain: Substance abuse by family members, reside in homes where domestic discord or violence is present, have family members who a history of involvement with the criminal justice system and need assistance with providing parental supervision.

School Domain: School behavior problems and poor academic performance.

Applicants are being sought that are able to address items below:

1. Program services compatible with research that are shown to be effective with juvenile offenders.
2. Program services are outcome-based.
3. The program has an evaluation component.
4. Program services detect gang participation and divert individuals.
5. The program has a transportation component.
6. The program serves ages 6 years - 17 years.
7. Program has a plan of family engagement.

Local public agencies, 501(c)(3) non-profit corporations and local housing authorities are invited to submit applications to provide services addressing the above elements.

The program agreement is projected to be available in NC ALLIES the first full week of January. Applicants are required to attend an information session on February 12, 2019 at 3:00 p.m. at Wilkes County Juvenile Justice Conference Room. This meeting is mandatory. All applicants should bring one copy of their application to the JCPC meeting scheduled for March 26, 2019 at 12:00 p.m. in the Ashe County Agricultural Extension Building first floor meeting room. Applicants should be prepared to make a brief presentation of their proposal during the meeting.
