Bids may be submitted by mail or courier. Bids received after this time will not be accepted.

The project scope consists of pad grading for a future industrial park and all associated erosion control measures. The site contains trout buffered streams and an existing road (Industry Way) with utilities service stubs for the future industrial users. Special care shall be taken to avoid impacting the existing streams, buffers and infrastructure.
