The Business Sustainability Roundtable (BSR) is a council of regional governments, businesses, and stakeholders with a shared purpose: bring together leaders from government, business, and academia to collaborate on key sustainability and economic development challenges facing the region.

History

The BSR was founded by Duke Energy, SAS, North Carolina State University, John Deere – Turf Care, Credit Suisse/UBS, Wake County Government, and FUJIFILM Diosynth Biotechnologies, and is now facilitated by the Wake County Economic Development, a program of the Greater Raleigh Chamber of Commerce.

Together, the Roundtable focuses on the achievement of measurable results for sustainability and business, and in the development of strong peer-to-peer mentorship opportunities to motivate excellence, improvement and impact.

Membership

Membership is open to the Greater Raleigh Community. Anyone is free to join one of the BSR sponsored upskilling sessions on prominent sustainability topics, attend BSR focused events hosted by Wake County Economic Development, or explore the website and dashboard for regional context and case studies.
