Forge Battery, part of Colorado-based Forge Nano, announces plans to launch a lithium-Ion battery manufacturing facility in Morrisville, NC. The company and its investors plan for an initial investment of more than \$165M (\$142,000 in capital investment) to build a new lithium-ion battery manufacturing facility in Morrisville, bringing more than 200 high-paying jobs to Wake County. Nano Battery will produce high-energy and high-power lithium-ion battery cells for defense, aerospace and specialty electric vehicle markets at the facility. If all goes as expected, production will begin in 2026. The company selected CaMP Morrisville, located at 401 Southport Dr. in Morrisville for their new operation. CaMP Morrisville is a purpose-built cGMP facility designed to support life science and advanced manufacturing operations. According to the incentives agreement, Forge plans to pay minimum average wages of about \$82,100. Audemars Piguet, the Swiss Haute Horlogerie manufacturer based in Le Brassus, Switzerland, announced today plans to invest \$22 million and create 105 new jobs in Raleigh. Luxury Watch Brand, Audemars Piguet employs almost 3,000 people, operates 97 points of sales globally and keeps growing internationally while focusing on qualitative development, employee wellbeing and sustainability, partly thanks to the work of the Audemars Piguet Foundation since 1992. Raleigh Iron Works will be the new home of their North American Service Center. The 63,000-square-foot real estate deal, the largest new-to-market office lease of the year so far in Raleigh, is part of a growing cohort of luxury brands establishing a presence in the city. The watch service center is in a City of Raleigh priority area for economic development and a Wake County targeted growth area. Targeted growth areas were identified to promote economic mobility in strategic communities that have not historically benefited from the region's economic growth. This announcement was made possible through the collaboration of a key group of partners including Wake County Economic Development, Raleigh Economic Development, the City of Raleigh, Wake County Board of Commissioners, Capital Area Workforce Development Board, North Carolina State University, Wake Technical Community College and the Economic Development Partnership of North Carolina.

Matt Neal, who runs Siemens Energy's grid solutions business in Raleigh, said that while the manufacturing investment (and most of the jobs) will go to Charlotte, the stakes for the Triangle are high too. That's because nearly 84 jobs coming to Raleigh as part of the deal are primarily in engineering, which often come with higher paychecks.

All of the jobs are high-paying, with minimum wages of more than \$87,000, according to what the company told the state about its plans for both Mecklenburg and Wake counties. When asked if the Raleigh jobs might pay more than what's being promised to Charlotte, Neal said the local positions "are more white collar jobs than manufacturing positions."

WakeMed has secured approval to add hospital beds to facilities in Wake County, beating out competing proposals from Duke Health and UNC Health. State regulators in late January approved WakeMed's applications to add the beds to existing facilities in Cary and north Raleigh. Meanwhile, regulators denied the proposals put forth by Duke Health and UNC Health. The approval means WakeMed can move forward in developing a 121,000-square-foot patient tower at WakeMed North Hospital on Falls of Neuse Road. The 5-story tower would include 35 acute care beds and 15 observation beds. The Raleigh-based health system estimates a total projected capital cost of about \$157.8 million.
